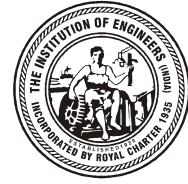

National Design and Research Forum (NDRF) invites entries for the 41st All India Student Design Competition - 2010.

The disciplines in which the competition is open are :

1. Aerospace Engineering
2. Agricultural Engineering
3. Architectural Engineering
4. Chemical Engineering
5. Civil Engineering
6. Computer Engineering
7. Electrical Engineering
8. Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering
9. Environmental Engineering
10. Marine Engineering
11. Mechanical Engineering
12. Metallurgical and Materials Engineering
13. Mining Engineering
14. Production Engineering
15. Textile Engineering

Three Prizes would be awarded in each of the fifteen disciplines adjudged best in order of merit, to be decided by a Panel of Judges.

The Prizes would be:

- FIRST PRIZE : Gold Medal**
SECOND PRIZE : Silver Medal
THIRD PRIZE : Bronze Medal

Besides the Prize, winners will also be given a Certificate of Appreciation.

The Competition is open to the final and pre-final year students of BE / B.Tech / ME / M.Tech / MS or equivalent courses in Engineering from Indian Universities, IITs, IISc and also for the Senior Technician/Technician Members of IEI who have passed AMIE Examination. **This Competition is intended to give students an opportunity to exhibit their individual engineering skills and talents and earn recognition, while promoting engineering Design and Research.**

Participants are requested to see overleaf regarding details of entry conditions to be complied with. The entries with complete details should reach NDRF on or before **17 August 2010** to be considered in this competition.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Competition is for individual students only. **JOINT ENTRIES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
2. Students may submit any design which is done either as a part of the program of his/her engineering studies or a design specially worked out for the competition. If a team of students have jointly done a project, the Principal/HOD should certify (Certificate of Authenticity) the role played by the student entering the competition and also the percentage he would assess is the concerned students contribution to the total design project.
3. There is no entry fee.
4. Each student can participate in any one discipline only.
5. The design project for the competition must not exceed 20 pages of standard A4 size (single side). The design project must contain description about the design, brief history of the existing technology, improvements proposed and the conclusion/s.
6. If, in the opinion of judges, there are not sufficient number of entries, or, if the entries do not measure upto the required standards, NDRF reserves the right to alter the prizes or to combine and divide the prizes in any manner it deems fit.
7. The competitors are required to submit a signed declaration stating that the design project for the competition is entirely their own and completely fill up the Participant Detail Form.
8. The Awardees will be intimated about the date and venue of award presentation.
9. The entries for the Competition must be sent to **Director, National Design and Research Forum, The Institution of Engineers (I), No. 3, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Veedhi, Bangalore - 560 001** by registered post or personally handed over at NDRF office.
10. Records and drawings submitted at the time of entry will not be returned.
11. **In all cases, the decision of the National Design and Research Forum would be final and binding on all the participants.**
12. Please superscribe on the envelope "41st All India Student Design Competition - 2010 in Discipline".
13. No interim correspondence will be entertained.
14. **Last date for receiving entries is 17 August 2010.**
